- Location/Benue:** Goggausee; Municipality of Steuerberg / Carinthia, Austria
- Reserve venue:** Asphalt Anlage (Parking slot, length 140m) at the Jaques Lemans Arena at St. Veit / Glan / Carinthia / AUT
- Date:** Friday, 26th to Sunday, 28th January 2024
- Timetable:** The provisional schedule can be found in the appendix, page 4.
- Competitions:** Distance competition Women/Men, Juniors (U 23) and Youth (U19 and U16)
Individual competition / Teamevent / Team Mixed
- Starting eligibility:** Only players who belong to a national member federation that is affiliated to the IFI have the right to start. (Juniors aged 23 and under but older than 14 on 1 October of the season; U19s aged 19 and under on 1 October of the season; U16s aged 16 and under on 1 October of the season).
- Authorisation:** 4 participants per member national federation. Player passports must be presented.
- Closimng date:** All entries must be received by the IFI office, International Federation Icestocksport, Otto-Fleck-Schneise 12, D-60528 Frankfurt am Main,
email: office@icestock.sport, **by 31 December 2023** at the latest.

The entries must contain precise details of how many players the member associations are obliged to enter and the addresses of the participants. According to the congress decision, entries received after this date will not be considered.
- Valuation:** Internationale Eisstockregeln (IER) 2022 and Internationale Spielordnung (ISpO) 2022 in conjunction with the current implementation regulations for IFI-Wettbewerbe - DfB.
The organiser provides the sports equipment in accordance with IER 621 to 624. Playback point according to Fig. 14 IER.
- Entry fee:** The entry fee is CHF 15.00 or EURO 15.00 per participant and must be paid at the time of registration.



Testing of sports equipment:

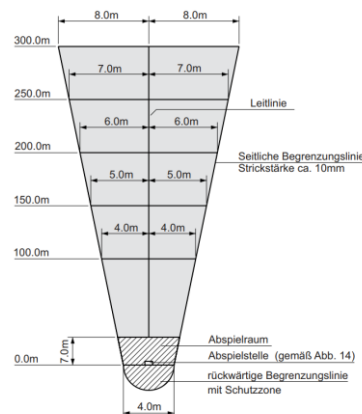
The stems used should have been checked by a preliminary inspection. The inspection of the stems is based on the DfB-10.12.2022 for IFI competitions in accordance with the current guidelines for the use of the IFI test kit (as of 01.10.23). A separate/own test protocol is not necessary. A maximum of 3 handles per player may be submitted for sports equipment inspection. These will be randomly checked on site and then fully and completely registered. A corresponding sticker for admission to the competitions will be affixed on site by the test referees. Remove existing stickers/seals! If a handle does not fulfil the test criteria, it will be confiscated. A maximum of 1 handle per starter may be submitted subsequently.

Victory ceremony:

The winners are honoured in accordance with § 422 ISpO and IFI-DfB..

Note:

The organiser provides the sports equipment in accordance with IER 621 to 624. Playing point according to Fig. 14 IER. The dimensions of the competition rink correspond to the specifications for natural ice rinks described in the previous regulations (10m / 150m).
